

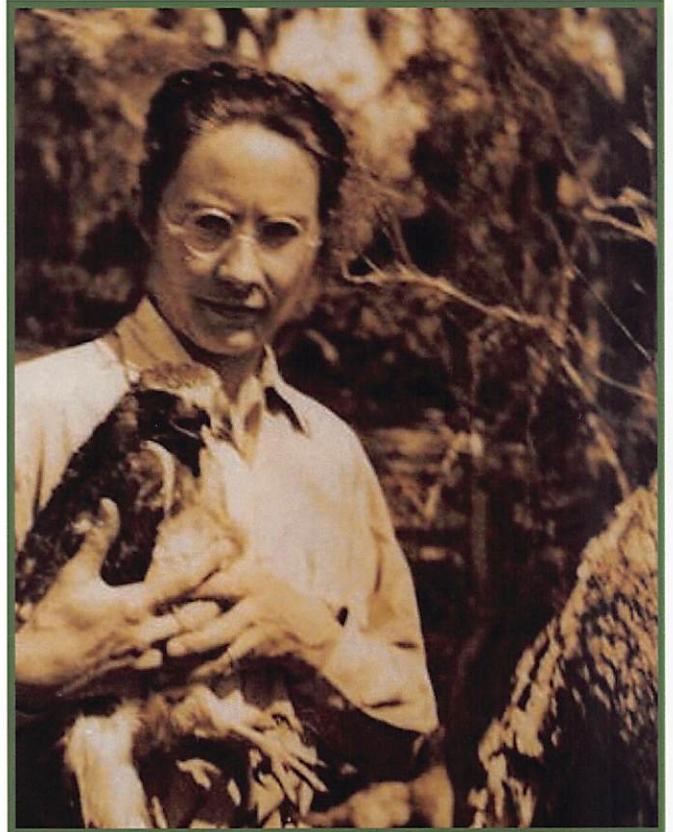
Lisa Von Borowsky

Lisa came to the US from Germany as a young adult and was hired by Margaret Dreier Robins to work at Chinsegut.

After a brief stint as housekeeper, Margaret moved Lisa into groundskeeping because of Lisa's talent for making Margaret's exotic plants flourish. Her passion for wildlife and natural Florida led her to help found local and State preserves. Lisa stayed with the Robins until their deaths and became known as the "Daughter of Chinsegut."



Lisa lived in the Chinsegut annex, which she filled with wild animals that needed her care. She left her windows open "*so the birds could come in and out.*"
